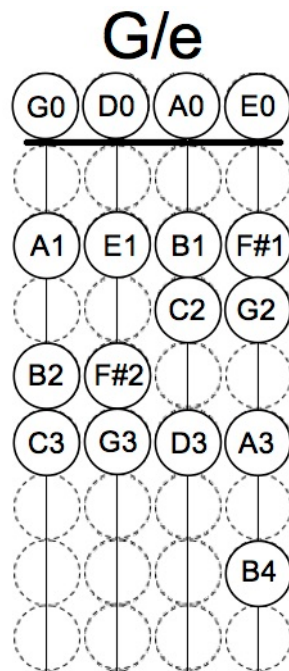


# Sally Brown
